## The Department of Medical Imaging Welcomes Dr. Bital Savir-Baruch, Nuclear Radiologist

Dr. Savir-Baruch joins us from Loyola University Medical Center where she is an Associate Professor of Radiology specializing in Nuclear Medicine.

Dr. Savir-Baruch received her Doctor of Medicine from Semmelweis University in Budapest, Hungary. After completing her Medical Degree, she accepted a Nuclear Medicine Research Associate position at Emory University's Department of Radiology and Imaging Science. Following her General Surgery Internship, Dr. Savir-Baruch completed a Nuclear Medicine Residency at Emory University.



In addition to clinical expertise in diagnosing and managing prostate, thyroid, neuroendocrine, and breast cancers, Dr. Savir-Baruch specializes in diagnosing patients with cardiac amyloidosis and sarcoidosis. She is board-certified in Nuclear Medicine and Nuclear Cardiology.

Dr. Savir–Baruch is passionate about research, patient care, and education, having served as a principal investigator of clinical trials, a mentor for Pathway for Added Certification in Education (PACE), a Team/ Family leader, and a Core Faculty member in the Diagnostic Residency Program.

Dr. Savir-Baruch is an active member of many professional societies currently serving as secretary and co-chair of various committees within the Society of Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging (SNMMI) and the American College of Nuclear Medicine (ACNM). Dr. Savir-Baruch was recently presented with the *President Award* at the 2020 annual meeting of ACNM, and she was awarded the *Hal O'Brien Rising Star Award* at the 2019 High Country Meeting of SNMMI.
